Precept

The Parish Precept for 2012/2013 will be increased from £13,300 to £15,310. In monetary terms this is an increase of approximately £4.50 for a band D household for the whole year although we appreciate it is an increase of approximately 15% as it will be shown on your council tax bill when you receive it.

Road Safety at Swan Bridge Junction

The Parish Council continue to press for improvements to be made to this junction and are hopeful that funding will be provided by the County Council in this financial year. Plans are currently being drawn up by the County Council's Highways team with their suggestions for improvements.

Reporting Crime

Please make sure that all crimes are reported to the Police as we have had several recent reports of crimes particularly anti social behaviour and vandalism but the Police have not been told about them. If crimes are not reported then the Police will not be aware of any problems in our area and will concentrate their resources elsewhere. Crimes can be reported anonymously by contacting Crime Stoppers on 0800 555 111 or Cambridgeshire Constabulary on 0845 456 4564.

Exception Sites for Affordable Houses

The Council are still trying to progress an Exception Site for Affordable Houses in Parson Drove on a site next to the Doctors Surgery at Church End.

Safer Routes to School Scheme

As a result of grant funding being obtained from Fenland District Council and funding from the County Council a new traffic calming scheme will be installed outside the Payne Primary School by the County Council Highways authority during February.

Highway Fault Reporting System

Cambridgeshire County Council has an interactive on-line reporting system for highway problems which will ensure the person reporting a fault is kept fully up to speed with its repair. Care & Repair

The Fenland Handyperson Service for people aged 60 years or over and people with disability or long-term ill health is supported by Fenland District Council. The scheme covers home security, smoke detectors, general repairs and odd jobs, minor plumbing and electrical work and home energy improvements.
