Also in attendance were and CCC S King, Clerk David Boyce as well as one member of the public.

Cllr G Booth Chaired the meeting and opened it at 19:30.

1. Chairman's Welcome

Cllr Gavin Booth opened the meeting and welcomed members back to a face to face meeting. Then the Chairman took apologies from Cllrs P Unwin, R Fowler and C Kilingworth. The Chairman informed members that there had been no meeting nor minutes last year in respect of the Pandemic, with the previous years having already been agreed as a true record.

A member of the public enquired as to the status of a safer walkway that was being worked on between Parson Drove and Murrow. It was also explained that due to the pandemic this had been put on hold but could be explored again.
